Hogans	Hazy Rays	3.9	Med-sweet. A deliciously light, fruity moreish fresh pressed hazy cider. A best seller with an abundant appley aroma to the nose. A hint of citrus and berry delicately balanced against the apple sweetness on the palate.
Gwynt y Ddraig	Autumn Magic	4	Cider with wild blackberries; scrumptious colour bursting with fruity aroma
Celtic Marches	Cuckoo Penny	4	Yorkshire triangle Timperley Rhubarb juice with Herefordshire cider to create a subtle flavour and a refreshing bite at the end
Barbourne	Strawberry	4	Med-sweet, deliciously fruity and bursting with the flavours of summer
Lilleys	Pear & Raspberry	4	Sweet, a great blend of Somerset cider and pear & raspberry juice
Hogans	Wild Elder	4	Med-sweet. Delicately sweet hand foraged elderflower is expertly blended with 100% fresh pressed cider.
Hogans	Hip Hop	4	Medium. A proper mash up, authentic bittersweet fresh pressed cider with a touch of aromatic English hops
Cotswold Cider	Muscle Mary	4	Medium, raspberry blush, flawless in pink, light in its loafers, with a surprisingly firm handshake
Lilleys	Lemon & Ginger	4	Med-dry, expertly blended to bring out the zing and the lemon & ginger
Snailsbank	Fruit bat	4	Med. Crisp apple cider blended with strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant
Lilleys	Apple & Blackberry	4	Sweet, crisp Somerset cider blended with apply & blackberry juice wonderfully fruity and sweet.
Lilleys	Merry Monkey	4.5	Med, made with unfiltered bittersweet apple, full of character with a rich appley flavour
Gwynt y Ddraig	Hazy Daze	4.5	Med. A new cider, fruity, apply aroma, well balanced finish. Light and easy to drink
Celtic Marches	Lily the Pink	4.5	Med. Fruity, gorgeous pink colour from 100% cider apples on their Herefordshire farm. Intense fruity aroma – very drinkable
Hogans	Libertine	4.8	Med. Indulgent, sweetly satisfying, burnt umber, dark, bittersweet, rich in tannic cider with unusual depth, wild radical brooding and delicious
Cockeyed Cider	Mad Jack	5	Dry- traditional cider blended from Tannic Cider apples
Barbourne	Golden drop	5	Med. Worcestershire apples slightly cloudy, blended with Red Falstaff for a fruity finish
Snails Bank	Appley Dapply	5.2	Sweet. Lively cider, blend traditional bitter sweet apples with a more contemporary Russett to make a light refreshing and quaffable cider
Hogans	Harvest Press	5.3	Med-dry. Distinctively fresh bittersweet cloudy cider, challenging enough to be easy drinking. A real taste of the orchard.

Gwyn y Ddraig	Farmhouse Scrumpy	5.3 Medium Dry - Cloudy a fresh apple aroma, good with a chunk of bread and cheese
Caney's Cider	Redstreak	6 Medium- single variety Dabinet pleasant drinkable all day cider
Lilleys	Red Rabbit	6 Med-dry. A rich and fruity rustic cloudy cider bursting with apple flavour.
Broad Oak	Bristol Port	6 Med-dry. Somerset cider
Hogans	French Revelation	6.2 Med-dry. Something a little different for the more curious. Breton style, born from the process of keiving.
Hogans	Panking Pole	6.2 Dry- Traditional strong complex and dry as a bone.
Snailsbank	Pigs Squeal	7 A rich bronze cider smooth and tasty. Beautifully balanced with a satisfying rounded finish
Farmer Jims	Copper Top	7.4 Dry cloudy
Orchard Pig	Hog Father	7.4 Med. Not for the faint hearted
Farmer Jim	Apple Red	8.4 Med Dry. Fruity aromas and a legbender for sure.
